## The Dishonest Manager | Luke 16:1-13

### Warm Up

- This is a strange one! What are your first impressions of this parable?
- How does an understanding of the context help us better understand this parable? Who's listening? What are their characteristics? What similar themes run through Jesus' previous parable?

### Dig In

- Read Luke 16:1-8 and summarize the parable in your own words.
- What do you think Jesus is getting at in the end of verse 8 when he says, *"For the sons of men are more shrewd in dealing with their own generation than the sons of light"*?

**Apply:** The application of this parable is found in verses 9-13. Read each passage and point of application and discuss specific ways to apply each point.

- V. 9 - Don't Waste Your Wealth, Invest Eternally
- V. 10-12 - Be Faithful With What's In Front Of You
- V. 13 - Be Single-Minded In Who You Serve
