

# Sermon Supplement from July 23

## The Wonderful Works and Word of God | Psalm 19

### Warm Up

- Talk about some things in nature that you have found most awe-inspiring.
- Talk about a time when you have significantly experienced God through His Word.

### Dig In

Read Psalm 19:1-6

- What does nature teach us about the nature and character of God?
- Respond to this statement: *“Horizontal awe is only meant to stimulate vertical awe.”*
- Brainstorm some creative ways Christians of all ages could practice experiencing God’s works in nature.
- In what ways is natural revelation insufficient?

Read Psalm 19:7-10

- How do the descriptors in vv. 7-10 give you a better understanding of what God’s Word is like and what it does?
- What are some of your personal favorite descriptors in these verses? Why?
- How does this understanding of God’s Word impact how much time you devote to it?

Read Psalm 19:11-14

- How does experiencing God’s Works and understanding God’s Word impact your Walk?

**Wrap Up:** This week set aside some specific time to put down your phone, pick up a paper Bible, and go outside. Reflect on God’s Works, read God’s Word, ask God to impact your Walk with Him.
