Proverbs #8 - Money

WARM UP - Have you ever...

- Spent money just to impress someone
- Shopped irresponsibly with a credit card
- Wished you could have things you can't afford
- Bought something you didn't need or even want
- · Bought something because you were jealous of someone else's stuff
- · Bought something just to make yourself feel better

DIG IN

Use the following Proverbs to gauge your attitude toward money. What do these verses reveal?

If money is your god...

- 1. You will use money to impress people (12:9, 13:7)
- 2. You will spend beyond your means (21:17)
- 3. You will use people to get money (20:17, 21:6, 28:8)
- 4. You will be eager to get rich and chase easy money (28:19-20)
- 5. You will lend and borrow irresponsibly (22:7; 22:26-27)
- 6. You will pursue money at the expense of more important things (23:4-5)
- 7. You will put your hope in your money (11:28; 18:11)

If money is your gift...

- 1. You will use your money to honor God (3:9-10)
- 2. You will use money to bless others (11:24-25; 22:9)
- 3. You will be diligent in work (10:4; 13:11)
- 4. You will have a responsible savings plan (21:20; 6:6-8)
- 5. You will have a heart for the hurting (14:21; 19:17; 28:27)
- 6. You will steward your gift well (27:23-27)
- 7. You will leave a legacy (13:22)
