Grounded in the Word (pt 1) – 2 Timothy 3

WARM UP

- What excites you about what God is currently doing at PCBC?
- In what ways could activities and opportunities turn into distractions?
- What do you think about the focusing phrase “*Grounded in the Word, Growing in Worship*”?

DIG IN

Read 2 Timothy 3:1-9

- What do these verses teach about what can happen when we are not grounded in the Word?
- What are some things our culture has in common with these verses?

Read 2 Timothy 3:10-13

- How do these verses help us see the necessity of remaining grounded in the Word?
- In what ways has “the tide changed” in our culture so that it is no longer socially respectable to be a Christian?

Read 2 Timothy 3:14-17

- What specific ways do these verses teach us to be grounded in the Word?
- What indispensable convictions about God’s Word do we learn from these verses? Why are these convictions so important?
- In what ways are you receiving coaching in the Word?
- How does the Word make us “*complete, equipped for every good work*”?

WRAP UP

- What are some specific steps you will take to be grounded in the Word?
- This week read Psalm 119 and think about the value of God’s Word in your life.
