“Welcomed In” – Romans 11:11-24

WARM UP

- Talk about a time you felt welcomed. What was your response? What impact did that have on your life?

DIG IN

Read vv. 11-16 | The Welcome

- How does this passage demonstrate that God’s plan is not thwarted by man’s rejection?
- What hope does it give you to know that God is always up to something good?
- What do we learn about the future of the Jews from these verses?
- What message does Paul have for the Gentiles in these verses?

Read vv. 17-24 | The Warnings

- Look for all the commands in this passage. What do you see?
- In what ways is this passage a warning against arrogance?
- In what ways is this passage a warning against apostasy?
- In what ways is this passage a warning against antisemitism?
- How would you explain the balance between God’s kindness and severity?

Wrap Up

- In what ways do you see God’s heart for people on display in this passage? How does that cause you to respond?
- What’s one way this passage challenges or shapes your attitude and actions?
- Is there a verse or phrase from this passage you want to carry with you and reflect on this week?
